### OPEN TO ME THE DOORS OF REPENTANCE, O LIFE-GIVER.



Dear Ones in Christ,

Special evenings, 5PM to 8PM, reserved for the Sacrament of Confession in preparation for Holy Pascha will begin this Tuesday, April 2<sup>nd</sup>. They are listed below. If any of these times and days are not possible for you, you may request a time and day that is. We all need to come to Confession to prepare ourselves to meet Christ at His Holy Pascha. As Orthodox Christians we are taught from early childhood of the need for Holy Confession. Let us make every sincere effort to avail ourselves of these dates and times for Holy Confession.

Of constant concern to me are those of you who have not been coming to Confession as often as we should or at all. Our Lord, His saints, Sacred Scripture, and the teachings of our faith remind us of the fundamental necessity of repentance in the Christian life. Dispensing with it results in our distancing from God, loss of fervor and love, and a general disinterest in life, faith, and spiritual understanding no matter how good, kind, generous, honest, and well-intentioned we may be. Through the Sacrament of Confession, we receive reconciliation, cleansing, refreshment, rebirth, renewal, and freedom, and we return to that initial unity with God that we received in Baptism and which Adam shared with Him in Paradise.

As always, I ask you all to come to Confession as early as you can and not to postpone it to the end of the Great Fast. Remember that there will be no confessions from Lazarus Friday, April 26th through Thomas Sunday, May 12th, because of the intensity of the Passion Week liturgical cycle and the nature of its significance.
